






PITFALLS

Common item-writing errors that make questions **EASIER**








A clue in the stem points test-takers to the correct answer choice

You often see this on jeopardy









A grammatical cue points test-takers to the correct answer choice



PITFALL#3: BAD SYNTAX






Sentence structure that makes only one answer choice correctly fit the question stem




PITFALL #4: **ABSOLUTES**





Answer choices with words like "all", "every", "always", "only", "never", and "none"






The longest answer stands out and test-takers are drawn to the longest answer choice



PITFALL#6: CONVERGENCE







Convergence occurs when there are multiple answer choices with the same answer (or part of the same answer)




PITFALL#7: IMPLAUSIBLE CHOICES





Answer choices are not plausible and can be easily eliminated






One question is a hollaback (provides the correct answer to another question)








Choice: What are the options for response/action?

Challenge: What am I being asked to do? What is in it for me? Why does this matter?


Consequences: What type of feedback will I receive for my choice?

WEBB'S DEPTH OF KNOWLEDGE




A framework for dividing learner's cognitive tasks into increasing levels of difficulty and complexity.

OOK Level 1	Recall	Who? What? Where? How?
OOK Level 2	Application of Skills	How did it happen? What is the result?
OOK Level 3	Strategic Thinking	Why did it happen? What was the cause and effect?
OOK Level 4	Extended Thinking	What is the impact? What might happen if












